Step
01

A foundational mentorship program for boys and girls between 9 and 13 rooted in our “Five Tenets For Triumphant Children” workbook.

Step
02

An initiation focused mentorship program for boys between 13 and 16 years tailor made to effectively transition boys into young men.

Step
03

A High School oriented mentorship program for teens between 14 and 18 that reveals and puts emphasis on the things that actually matter during those four school years

Step
04

A campus oriented coaching program for young adults between 17 and 21 that instills hands on real world skills for both personal and professional use

Step
05

An intensive coaching program for young professionals between 20 and 25 who can plug into any of the previous programs

Our initiation program will run as a ten day camp jam packed with several activities and teaching methodologies that cultivate wisdom, foster maturity and impart relevant life skills to the boys as they recuperate in a homely environment.

The boys will get challenged physically through a moderatley intensive hike and will be given a mental,

behavioral and spiritual priming through guided sessions with invited speakers and our in house facilitators

We will also work collaboratively with the parents, as they play the roles detailed later, to effectively celebrate this milestone over some nyam chom and a commissioning ceremony

Our Curriculum

Everything we teach is designed to guide a child towards becoming the best version of themselves possible. Therefore, our course material is taught by highly trained facilitators during sessions that make use of our interactive guidebook. The guidebook contains the stories of several noteworthy Biblical characters, remarkable figures of history, powerful quotes and modern real-world examples and will be used to cover the topics outlined below.

Note that attending camp and completing the guidebook sets them up for our follow up programs which run from highschool all through to university

Should make it clear to their son the importance of the milestone they are passing and actively encourage them to embrace and live up to the new expectations that will be set for them.

Should appoint a lead dad for coordination and communication purposes to guarantee the success of the nyam chom and commissioning days as they are highly collaborative.

Should feel free to bring any goodies for their son while keeping in mind that they should be adequate for everyone at camp.

MOTHERS

Should communicate the importance of a noticeable change after the rite and the various new responsibilities that the young men should step up to

Should actively provide opportunities for the young men to practice responsibility and dependability especially around the home

Should intercede for all the young men, medical staff, speakers, facilitators and support staff as the entire program runs its course

Frequently Asked Questions

01 Q: What does my payment cover?

A: The payment covers accomodation and meals, doctor and nurses fees, speakers, facilitators and complimentary gifts.

02 Q: Will my son be okay?

A: The operation is considered to be a minor surgery and heals relatively quickly. While at camp, the boys will be cared for and shown what to do and what to avoid thus ensuring a quick recovery.

03 Q: What if my son has already been circumcised?

A: There's a different camp for boys who have already been circumcised and the dynamics of this camp are better suited for the needs of both the parent and that child. Enroll your son for that camp instead.

04 Q: Are there any programs for parents?

A: We will have parents meetings that discuss the finer details of the camp and also pass on information on how to better parent teens. A structured program is on its way.

05 Q: Is Nawiri Experiences a Christian organization?

A: We are a faith based organization in pursuit of Christ's eternal objectives and as we teach, we ensure that this mindset is shared by all our staff and partners.

The Sign up Process

We're ready to have you on board with us. But before you sign up, here's a few things you should know:

Registration

To register, fill out [this](#) form. Once done, we will reach out to you with an invoice and provide more information on pre-camp classes and parent's meeting dates. We highly recommend paying at least 10% of the total camp cost as a booking fee to secure a slot

Operation

We worked with the same medical team for over ten years and there shall be a question and answer session meeting between the lead doctor, the parents and the boys

Communication

A Telegram group will be formed for group communication purposes and it will be the main hub for all updates

Venue

A meet and greet with all the parents will be held just before camp at the designated venue

Our guarantee is that our programs provide the best experiences for all parties involved. This means that by design camp is convenient for parents and guardians, and lifechanging and memorable for the children.

No need to buy shukas, plates or spoons. We've got those covered! Here's what to carry:

- A Bible
- A Notebook and Pens
- A NEW bucket
- Comfortable Casual wear; several t-shirts and a few loose fitting shorts (one should be black)
- Bedding (mattresses will be provided)
- Laundry Soap and Antiseptic bathing soap
- Comfortable Hiking shoes and sandals
- Personal effects; A towel, toothbrush, face towel, 4 tissues, underwear etc
- A torch and batteries
- A new shaving Razor
- Two new handkerchiefs (preferably white)
- Savlon antiseptic (250ml)
- Warm jackets
- Water bottle

The boys are free to bring books , board games, or musical instruments.

However, we insist that no mobile phones or electronic devices be carried as they are anti-social and quite frankly unnecessary
